**Gratitude, a remedy tested against the pain of being at work.**

According to a recent study realised by a World Wide consultation firm in Human Resources, work produces more and more strong emotions and those emotions are mostly negative.

We can see a considerable distance between what the employees consider an ideal work experience and their actual experience. We no longer acknowledge the number of studies and surveys that corroborates the feeling that for a lot of employees, working is really not any fun.

**Causes:**

Here are a few that were quoted by the people when we interrogated them on the subject.

**Work load and uncertainty**

No matter where we are, the workload is heavy and always increasing. Comments and allusions are often to the effect of uncertainty of the companies faced with their Future. These factors are often related to phenomenon such as obligation for the organisation to remain competitive in the tough and demanding market. Many of us know that speech just like an old song.

**Boredom and lack of gratitude**

We often complain of being bored at work, that we don't have enough challenges.

However, the most recent comment concerns the lack of gratitude for the efforts made and the final results. Still, the organisation and his management have in had everything they need to modify the situation. Nothing can stop and organisation to value the efforts and realisations of its' members.

We are all aware that once the needs of surviving and security are fulfilled, self esteem is also a fundamental need for every human being. Everyone looks for an environment or a task that allows them to do something good, to be proud of themselves and what they do.

**The obstacles**

**The answers:**

**Management must give the example and establish a cultured company oriented towards performance. The capacity to acknowledge must be part of the key skills of the management.**

**Be able to recognise good work when you see it.**
